GRI promotes and develops this standardized approach to reporting to stimulate demand for sustainability information—which will benefit reporting organizations and those who use report information alike.

ABOUT THE GLOBAL REPORTING INITIATIVE (GRI)

The Global Reporting Initiative (GRI) is a non-governmental organization that develops and disseminates globally applicable voluntary Sustainability Reporting Guidelines.

The GRI started in 1997 as an initiative of the United Nations Environment Program and became independent in 2002. Headquartered in Amsterdam, the Netherlands, the GRI is an official collaborating center of the United Nations Environment Program (UNEP) and works in cooperation with the UN Global Compact.

The GRI develops the sustainability reporting guidelines through a multi-stakeholder process that incorporates the active participation of business, accountancy, investment, environmental, human rights, research and labor organizations from around the world.

Investment

The Training Fee is.

- Standard : Rp 10.000.000,- per person (USD 1.250)

- In addition, participants are eligible to receive a Certified Sustainability Reporting Specialist (CSRS) from NCSR after successful passing NCSR online examination and submit the assignment.
- CSRS is a professional certification in Sustainability Management and has around 200 graduates since late 2007 in Indonesia, Malaysia and the Philippines.
- Only CSRS graduates are eligible for the Certified Sustainability Reporting Assuror (CSRA) training which objective is to provide assurance on sustainability reporting and practices based on the AA1000 standards.
